## ENCROACHMENT ON KOTOKA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (KIA) LANDS

Ghana Airports Company Limited (GACL) wishes to inform the general public that it has in recent times observed a lot of encroachment on the Kotoka International Airport (KIA) lands which has adverse implications for aviation safety and security.

Consequently, the National Security in consultation with other stakeholders notably, Lands Commission, Town and Country Planning, La Dadekotopon and Ledzokuku Krowor Municipal Assemblies have declared KIA and its immediate environs as a security zone. All non-conforming developments within the Airport Security zone are prohibited.

GACL has subsequently embarked on a fencing project to secure its lands. This covers portions of the western, eastern and northern boundaries of the airport.

The general public is advised to contact the Ghana Airports Company Limited before dealing in any land transactions within the KIA Security zone.
